

## REQUIREMENTS OF DOCUMENTATION GENERAL PRACTITIONER AS A DOCTOR OF MEDICINE

### *EDUCATION OUTSIDE OF THE EU, DIPLOMA HAVING BEEN RECOGNIZED BY A MEMBER STATE OF THE EU*

- Certified copy of *passport*
- Certified copy of *Diploma*.
- An authorized translation of diploma into Swedish or English
- A certificate in that confirms that your training confirms with the **EC Directive** and fulfills the conditions of Article 28 of Directive 2005/36/EC. This certificate is usually named a *Certificate of Conformity*, and needs to be issued by the competent authority and be sent in its original form. The certificate must contain your name, date of birth and the date of your diploma and/or your license to practice.
- An authorized translation of this certificate into Swedish or English

If you don't have access to the *Certificate of Conformity* as above, you can instead present a translated and original form of a *Certificate of acquired rights*. More information about this can be found in the National Board of Health and Welfare's home page.

- *Certificate of Good Standing* or *Certificate of Current Professional Status*, in its original form and translated by the competent authority. This certificate must not be older than three months.

### ALSO,

- A certificate in original form from a competent authority that confirms that you have worked as a doctor of medicine within the EU country for more than three years. This certificate needs also to be translated by an authorized translator.
- A certified copy of *annexes of your degree* certificate in its original language, which contains detailed information of the length and content of the education's different parts, or official information with such information from the university. Also, a translation of this into English or Swedish by an authorized translator is required.
- A certified copy of your *proof of employment* in its original language, where your employer states your type and extent of employment, and your tasks. Also, a translation of this into English or Swedish by an authorized translator is required.
